State of the Association

President's Letter

With a warmer than usual February under our belts to remind us of the weather to come, I would like to join the entire Volunteer Board in welcoming you to another fantastic, exciting recreational season at TVWRA! Our thanks go out to the many members who took the time to complete our membership survey last December. You will see many of your comments reflected in the notes and changes detailed in this newsletter!

2009 and 2010 were incredible years for capital

improvements, and our drive to make more of our infrastructure lower maintenance has really paid off. Walking around the pool deck last month it was clear that if we blew off some leaves, washed down the vinyl siding and put some chairs out, we could almost open in a day. We will always keep improving the little things, though, so come out and join us on our April/May volunteer weekends to fine tune our pool before the May open houses!

Yes, we refinanced our loan last year and increased our association's

debt, but thanks to decades of sound fiscal management by our boards, we are in a position to pay ahead on that debt in this and coming years, still while maintaining and improving our pool grounds. The state of the association remains solid.

Along the same lines, we are very pleased to announce that our dues for returning members are, for the fourth year in a row, the same value-packed amount that they have been. In addition to this, we will be opening the pool an hour earlier on weekends and holidays, and

TVWRA experienced another successful year in 2010. Financially, we remain strong. Our membership totaled 253 families. We had 202 returning families, and 51 new families joined. We continue to closely monitor our fiscal expenses. The board reviewed recent years' operations and discussed the impact that rising expenses would have on our 2011 expenses. We listened to our membership comments on dues in the survey and were able to pass a balanced 2011 budget without raising dues levels again this year. As a board, we will continue to monitor all events and expenses to insure that we remain fiscally sound throughout the year. We hope holding our dues level will make your summer of fun even better. We know TVWRA is the best deal in summer fun you can find!

Survey Says . . . We Are Listening!

In December, the Board surveyed TVWRA's membership to gather information to be used in planning the direction for the association over the next several years. We had excellent response — 108 members, almost a third of the membership. Members were overwhelmingly happy with the value of their memberships. We received very constructive comments and have integrated many of them into our planning starting with the 2011 season.

Financially, 54% felt that we should maintain the facility and either save for a rainy day or prepay the mortgage. We will operate the season and evaluate the amount available to pay ahead on our loan at the end of the year. We had several comments regarding the bathrooms and have taken this on as a major maintenance project for this season. Other maintenance activities will be undertaken during our cleanup days in April and May.

You asked for dues to be held, and we worked a balanced budget that allowed for maintenance advances and an extended season with no increase in summer dues! We responded to the request to keep the pool open on weekends through September, and we expanded the weekend and holiday hours by opening an hour earlier! We continue to offer several membership options for families, individuals and seniors. For our full family members who have graduated to associate senior status, your voting privileges remain in tact. For these seniors, please note the year you originally paid your initiation dues on your application.

Members expressed their happiness with the social activities. We incorporated some suggestions for new pre- and post- season activities and will continue a strong variety of family and adult socials. We addressed smoking concerns voiced by offering a balance for our smoking and non-smoking members. We have designated the wading pool area, all covered buildings and wood decks as smoke free during regular pool hours. Valuable comments were provided regarding attracting additional swim team members and addressing the volunteer help needed at swim meets. The swim team committee and coaches will be using this information in their planning for the coming season.

The Board is very thankful for the comments and suggestions provided in the survey. The input will continue to be used in planning for future projects and activities. Anyone who has ever come out to a Friday Adult Water Volleyball Night has never been the same. It's addictive, you'll wish every Friday was Friday Adult Water Volleyball Night. It is a great way to meet members, get in shape, and jump start your weekend. We already have three nights on the calendar for 2011: June 24, July 22 and August 19. Games start at 8:30 pm and go until 10 pm. Mark your calendars! You must be 18 or older to play! We hope to have a *Spike* in attendance this year!!

Shuffleboard

In 2010, shuffleboard made its TVW debut. A year older and it still has that new game smell. TVW provides the equipment, you must provide the skill. Children are welcome to play. Please respect the equipment and use the equipment only on the court for its intended purpose. Equipment must be returned to the proper storage area after play. It's like being on a cruise — except: it's cheaper, no motion sickness, and the scenery never changes! There is no BORED in TVW's shuffleboard!

We will continue to offer substantial discounts for those returning full family members (members who have paid the initiation fee in prior years) who pay early. Pay by March 31 and summer dues remain \$385! If you prefer to pay by April 30, your returning dues are \$410. Any returning full family members who pay after April 30, will have summer dues of \$435. Associate family, individual, and senior membership dues remain the same as in 2010 provided that the dues are paid by March 31. **Note that this is a change for all associate members.** All membership structures and associated dues are listed on the application included in this mailing.

Our gate guard program continues to be a valuable service to our membership by restricting admittance to our pool to non-members and non-paying guests. There will be a limited number of gate guard positions open for the 2011 season. To be considered for the position, you must be at least a rising eighth grade student and be a member in good standing. Interested teens can contact Cathleen Smith (741-2115) for details.

Families will continue to sign in at the front desk as they arrive. The gate guard on duty will check to see that the individual signing in is a member in good standing. A child must be at least 11 years of age to use the pool facilities without the presence of a parent. Guests cannot be admitted without a member, and they must be signed into the Guest Register at the front desk. All members are required to sign their agreement to follow the TVWRA Rules and Regulations when they join the pool each year and complete the annual application. A copy of the current rules is included in this mailing. Please review these with all members of your family and make sure you share them with your guests too!! **Please make sure you sign your 2011 Application.**

Our members invited a record number of guests in 2010. Members are required to sign in all guests at the front desk. We will continue to sell guest passes at the front desk. The charge for guests is \$5 at the door. A sheet of five (5) guest tickets can be purchased in advance for \$20. Guest tickets include a space for the name, address and phone number for each guest. It is important that we know who is at our pool at all times for the safety of our members. We thank you in advance for your help in completing these guest tickets and for signing your guests into the register at the front desk.

We are always looking for new families to join our association. Guests/potential members are invited to our March 19 chili cook-off. Also, we are hosting four open houses this year: May 14, 15, 21 and 22 from 1 to 4 p.m. Bring a friend by to see the pool! Weather permitting, the pool will be open for a preseason swim during the open house hours! We offer numerous membership plans. Help TVWRA get the word out! Please do not put your own information on the posted list.

We also have Comment Cards available in the box to the right of the front desk. The board welcomes your comments (good and bad) about the association and its operations. If you leave your name on the card and want us to get back with you, we most certainly will! Responses to questions/comments will be posted for the membership periodically.
