After years of gathering input from our membership, raising funds for our new building fund, and taking the financial actions

needed to refinance the pool, we were in the position to start our rebuilding project. As promised last year, we tore down the old snack building and hired contractor Lisa and Company to construct our new warming kitchen and snack building. As we go to press, we are within a week of completion and final County inspection.

The new facility will give us the equipment we need to continue our fun social and swim team events. We will continue to offer

Sound Operations, No 2010 Dues Increase

TVWRA experienced another successful year in 2009. Financially, we remain strong. Our membership totaled 235 families. We had 208 returning families, and 27 new families joined. We continue to closely monitor our fiscal expenses. The board reviewed recent years' operations and discussed the impact that rising expenses would have on our 2010 expenses. We identified line items where we could cut costs without substantially affecting services and were able to pass a balanced 2010 budget without raising our dues levels again this year. As a board, we will continue to monitor all events and expenses to insure that we remain fiscally sound throughout the year. We hope holding our dues level will make your summer of fun even better. We know TVWRA is the best deal in summer fun you can find!

vending machines, filtered water, refrigerators and microwaves for our members. We will also have hot water in the new building!!! Of course, summer tunes will fill the air daily!

We are not stopping our improvements with the completion of the new building. Before opening day, we will construct a new and improved grill for everyone's use!!! We will build an outdoor cabaña shower with hot and cold running water and add vinyl siding to our main bath house. We will re-side and truss and roof the maintenance building. We have extended the black perimeter fencing around the entire facility. We will be adding tables and chairs to the wading pool area and replenish chairs throughout, as needed. We are also looking to improve our tennis courts and have purchased a tile system to resurface one of the courts! We will be adding new gravel to the parking lot and doing some landscaping and planting. Yes, we are on the move and we certainly need your help. Please come out on our clean up days and see the progress we have made and lend a helping hand!!!

Despite all the improvements, the board is pleased to announce that we will not need to raise our membership dues for 2010!!! We are continuing the early pay and save deadlines: March 31 and May 1. These early pay dates allow families to save \$50 off regular summer dues if paid by March 31 and \$25 if paid by May 1. Get your completed application and family dues in now!!!

I want to assure you that sound fiscal management is extremely important at TVWRA. We interviewed several pool management companies over the winter and negotiated a favorable two year contract with SwimMetro at the end of the process. We develop a realistic, balanced budget annually and review financial operations at each monthly board meeting. All checks written require two officer signatures. We also have an annual audit/review of our financial operations. We take advantage of opportunities to save money everywhere we can such as using donated goods and labor. Your elected board will continue to manage TVWRA in a responsible manner, always keeping TVWRA's strong financial condition and continued successful operations in the forefront.

We need our membership to volunteer throughout the year to help us hold down costs. If you have a spare refrigerator or microwave, let us know. Come out and help on the clean up days. Volunteer to help at our many social events. Help the swim team with its many activities. Step up to serve on the board in future years. The more help we have, the more we can do!!! You will be surprised how much fun much of this work really is!

I am optimistic about TVWRA's operations this year and look forward to another successful year. I am excited about being your pool president again this year. I encourage your questions and comments. I look forward to hearing from you soon. Let me know how you would like to help your association!

Our big news, of course, is the new building. Please give thanks to the “generations” of board members and other volunteers who have contributed their efforts through the years in planning and preparing for this facility and also to our loyal returning membership for making this and other capital improvements possible.

While we continue to budget an amount each year to save towards major repairs and upkeep that we are able to schedule (resurfacing the pool, for example), there will be many other projects completed this Spring that will add value and enjoyment to your experience at TVW as well as enhance our pool’s appearance.

The new black fencing that was done along with the baby pool area expansion last year has been extended to the rest of the pool area. We will add three more concrete tables and umbrellas to the baby pool area. We have found an economical way to resurface one of our tennis courts, eliminating the need for crack repair. Our beloved but swaybacked tool shed will have its “back” straightened and reroofed, then sided in vinyl to match the new building, along with the walls of our original building. The rinse shower will be replaced with an enclosed “beach shower/changing room” with hot and cold water. I could go on, but we want to surprise you with a few items, as well!

If you don’t like surprises, though, come get a sneak peek while helping to clean up your pool grounds on this year’s Pool Clean Up Days, April 17-18 and 24-25! While most of the above projects are being done professionally, we will have the normal variety of mini-projects that need doing in order to be ready for our Open Houses. Our clean up weekends are as much social as hard work—come bring whatever skill set you have and join us for some early sun and fun!

We will continue to offer substantial discounts for those returning full family members (members who have paid the initiation fee in prior years) who pay early. Pay by March 31 and summer dues remain \$385! If you prefer to pay by May 1, your returning dues are \$410. Any returning full family members who pay after May 1, will have summer dues of \$435. Other membership structures are listed on the application included in this mailing.

Our gate guard program continues to be a valuable service to our membership by restricting admittance to our pool to non-members and non-paying guests. There will be a limited number of gate guard positions open for the 2010 season. To be considered for the position, you must be at least a rising eighth grade student and be a member in good standing. Interested teens can contact Cathleen Smith (741-2115) for details.

Families will continue to sign in at the front desk as they arrive. The gate guard on duty will check to see that the individual signing in is a member in good standing. A child must be at least 11 years of age to use the pool facilities without the presence of a parent. Guests cannot be admitted without a member, and they must be signed into the Guest Register at the front desk. All members are required to sign their agreement to follow the TVWRA Rules and Regulations when they join the pool each year and complete the annual application. A copy of the current rules is included in this mailing. Please review these with all members of your family and make sure you share them with your guests too!! Please make sure you sign your 2010 Application.

Our members invited a record number of guests in 2009. Members are required to sign in all guests at the front desk. We will continue to sell guest passes at the front desk. The charge for guests is \$5 at the door. A sheet of five (5) guest tickets can be purchased in advance for \$20. Guest tickets include a space for the name, address and phone number for each guest. It is important that we know who is at our pool at all times for the safety of our members. We thank you in advance for your help in completing these guest tickets and for signing your guests into the register at the front desk.

We are always looking for new families to join our association. We are having four open houses this year: May 15, 16, 22 and 23 from 1 to 4 p.m. Bring a friend by to see the pool! Weather permitting, the pool will be open for a preseason swim during the open house hours! We offer numerous membership plans. Help TVWRA get the word out!
